TEACHER'S PLAYBOOK – ENCOURAGING REPONSIBILITY IN STUDENTS

How to promote responsibility in your children?

- Set Clear Rules: Make sure your students know what is expected of them, like turning in homework on time or participating in class. When students know the rules, they can follow them better.
- Give Them Control: Let students take charge of their learning. Encourage them to set their own goals and track their progress. This helps them feel responsible for their own success.
- Hold Them Accountable: Remind students that their actions have consequences. If they don't turn in homework or miss a class activity, explain how it affects their learning. Help them understand that responsibility leads to better results.

Ever met words that look different but surprisingly sound the same like long lost twins?


Similar-sounding words, or homophones, are words that sound the same but have different meanings and spellings, making them an interesting and sometimes tricky part of language.




