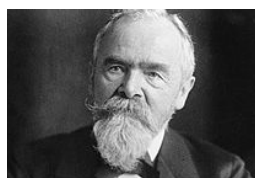
RETURN OF SUNITA WILLIAMS: HERO AMONG THE HEROES

Did you know half of the oxygen on our earth comes from Deep Sea Oceans?

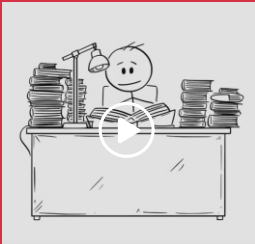

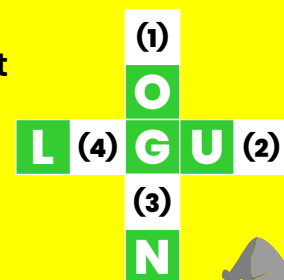

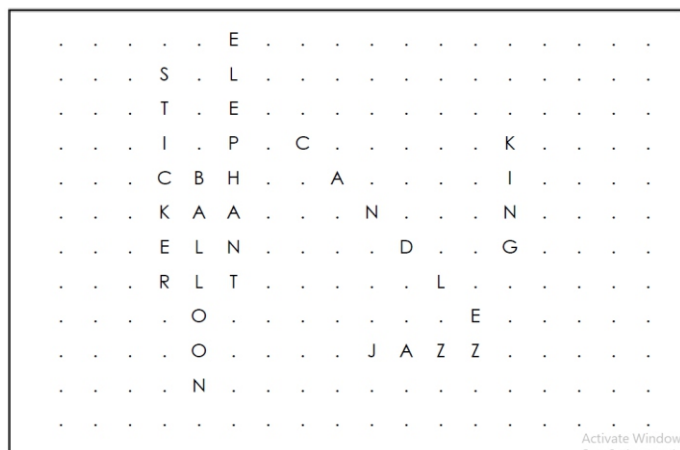
