

Teach students real-world application of concepts!

#### How do chemical reactions help in baking a cake?

- Soap contains molecules called surfactants. These have a hydrophilic head (water-loving) and a hydrophobic tail (water-repelling).
- The tail binds to grease and oil (nonpolar substances), while the head pulls it into water, forming structures called micelles.
- This breaks down lipids and dirt particles, washing germs away. The process doesn't just remove grime—it's chemistry in action!

#### DIY DIARIES: TURN CREATIVITY INTO CREATIVE LEARNINGS

#### **DIY Activity Paper Butterfly**

Here's a fun way to make your very own paper butterfly & decorate your room with your favourite colours! These paper butterflies are not only fun to make, but they're also a great way to practice your creativity! All you need are a few simple things:

Step-by-step guide

#### **Materials Needed:**

- Square paper (preferably 15x15 cm)
- Scissors
- Glue

#### Instructions:

- 1. Start with a Square Sheet: Begin with a square piece of paper.
- 2. Create a Fan Fold: Fold the paper back and forth in a fan-like manner (each fold is even).
- 3. **Secure the Centre**: Pinch the centre of the folded paper to form a crease.
- 4. Shape the Wings: Gently pull apart the ends of the folded paper to form the butterfly wings.
- 5. Add Final Touches: Optionally, cut the ends of the wings to create a more defined shape. Apply glue to secure the folds if necessary.

This simple yet charming paper butterfly can be used as a decoration, a bookmark, or a fun craft project for kids.


