

# **TEACHERS' HELPDESK**

## **OLYMPIAD PREPARATION STRATEGIES FOR TEACHERS**

Tips for Teaching Olympiad-Level Syllabus Effectively!

#### • Start With the 'Why' Before the 'How'

Show them the beauty or real-world impact of a concept before diving into formulas. A curious mind learns faster than a memorising one.

#### • Think in Layers, Not Leaps

Break tough problems into bite-sized logical steps. Guide them from intuition  $\rightarrow$  pattern  $\rightarrow$  principle  $\rightarrow$  proof.

Make Mistakes Normal (and Useful)

Discuss why wrong answers happen—it builds resilience. Olympiads are more about thinking than always being right.

#### • Practice is Strategy, Not Repetition

Don't just "do more problems"—reflect on how they solved it. Use past questions to teach techniques, not just test speed.

# **DIY DIARIES: TURN CREATIVITY INTO CREATIVE LEARNINGS**

#### How to Grow a Kidney Bean Plant in a Jar (Step-by-Step)

**Step 1: Soak the Beans** Place 1–2 kidney beans in water overnight to soften them.

#### Step 2: Prepare the Jar

Fill the bottom of a clear glass jar with moist cotton balls.

#### Step 3: Place the Beans

Gently press the soaked beans between the cotton and the jar wall so they're visible from outside.

#### Step 4: Add Water

Sprinkle a little water to keep the cotton damp, but not soaked.

#### Step 5: Set in Sunlight

Place the jar near a window where it gets indirect sunlight.

#### Step 6: Water Daily

Check the cotton every day and add a few drops of water to keep it moist.

#### Step 7: Observe Growth


In 2-3 days, roots will appear. In 4-5 days, the shoot will grow upward.

Step 8: Transplant (Optional)

After 10–14 days, you can move the plant to a pot with soil.
