Discovery of X-Rays

By Wilhelm Conrad Röntgen



In 1895, Wilhelm Conrad Röntgen discovered X-rays while experimenting with electrical currents. This invisible form of radiation allowed doctors to see inside the human body without surgery for the first time.

X-rays transformed medical diagnosis, making fractures, infections, and internal conditions visible within minutes.

One unexpected observation opened a new window into human health.

Why Does Ice Float on Water?

Most substances become denser when they freeze. But water behaves differently. When water cools and turns into ice, its molecules arrange themselves into a crystal structure that takes up more space. This expansion makes ice less dense than liquid water - and that is why ice floats.

This unique property plays a crucial role in nature. When lakes and ponds freeze during winter, the ice forms on the surface instead of sinking. The layer of ice acts like insulation, keeping the water below relatively warmer and allowing aquatic life to survive.

If ice sank, water bodies would freeze from the bottom up, disrupting entire ecosystems.

Scientific Conclusion:

An object floats if it is less dense than the liquid it is placed in. Water expands upon freezing, reducing its density and enabling ice to float.

Science often hides extraordinary principles in everyday observations.

How to Raise Academic Champions in Your School

- Identify early signs of logical curiosity and analytical thinking in students
- Regularly expose learners to unfamiliar and higher-order problem patterns
- Train students to read every question carefully—twice before answering
- Build exam stamina through structured, timed practice sessions
- Promote post-test analysis and reflection rather than focusing only on results

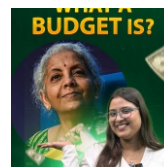
